

South Coast & Country Community Law can assist with Victims Support Scheme Applications.

Victims of crime, including domestic violence, may be able to access support under the Victims Support Scheme including:

Counselling

Up to 22 hours of counselling.

Financial assistance for immediate needs

Up to \$5,000 for expenses incurred urgently to secure the victim's safety, health and well being.

Financial assistance for economic loss

For out of pocket expenses, loss of actual earnings, medical and dental expenses, justice-related expenses, and assistance relating to the loss of or damage to personal effects such as clothing.

Recognition payment

Payments of \$1,500 to \$15,000 to recognise the trauma caused to the victim and the offence or offences committed against them.
